Primary Duties: Completes urban forestry duties and tree care for all trees on city properties and rights-of-way. Must have proficiency knowledge of knots, rigging, and all climbing gear; Must be able to climb trees up to 100 feet in height using a climbing rope and saddle, and lift up to 50 pounds; experience in operating an aerial lift truck, performing arboreal operations such as pruning and removal of hazard trees; climbing trees, removing trees adjacent to buildings and other structures; knowledge of daily maintenance and safe operation of all equipment used in tree care such as chain saws, aerial lift trucks, chippers, and stump grinders. Secondary Duties: Maintaining roads, parks and sanitation. Trash and recycling services; prepares, paves and maintains streets; plows and shovels snow; mows; trims grass & trees; dig graves; performs building maintenance - light plumbing and electric; operates heavy equipment: front-end loaders, dump trucks & back hoes; run street sweeper; tear out and rebuild basins. Lifts up to 50 pounds, shovels, digs, rakes, climbs, etc. High school diploma or equivalent; Commercial Driver License (Class B) required or must be able to obtain within 6 months; six months job-related experience.
